

HOLLY POINT BEACH AND TENNIS ASSOCIATION
ANNUAL MEETING
JUNE 24, 2012

The annual meeting of the Holly Point Beach and Tennis Association was called to order by Rick Shakalis at 11:05. As is customary, all members present introduced themselves.

The secretary's report was accepted as read.

Bill Masterson presented the Treasurer's Report. No unusual expenditures were made last year. There were 68 member families and 18 had not renewed. He reminded members that initiation fee is \$200 and annual membership remains at \$75/year

Chris Shakalis reported that the tennis courts have some cracks and that they should be repaired soon. A new lock will be installed on July 1st. Member Peggy Ginther has been keeping the sign up book for the court times and volunteered to do it again this summer.

Roger Bodley presented the beach report and noted that the water testing continues to show safe levels of bacterial colonies. A group from Woods Hole was hired by the town to test the ground water in the lake for phosphorus and nitrogen flow. The levels of these substances indicate that there is no ground water migration to lake beaches from the septic systems with the exception of the SW and NW corners of the lake, and none in the Holly Point area. Everyone was asked to keep the beach clean and to bring out everything they bring in. Please report to Roger any activity that is not in compliance with our goals.

Thanks were given to Maria and Alan who live next to the beach for their collection of the goose droppings on the float on a regular basis. He also thanked Paul Mullen for his work on the beach. Roger requested that people rake the beach and collect the debris but not the sand, and demonstrated how to use the rake or shovel to toss the debris over the trees behind the beach sand area.

Joyce Nadeau reported there were 4 new member families and two houses are currently for sale.

Dick Teimer, who set up the HPBTA website, asked for input for upcoming events and any news that should be shared. Some members expressed interest in possibly having a block party.

The following board members were up for renewal: Bill Masterson, Jim Nadeau, Claire Anderson, Leroy Anderson, Roger Bodley and Chris Shakalis and all were unanimously voted to be reinstated.

The meeting was concluded at 12:00.
